# PROGRAMME MAMMOGRAPHIE

Free screening for women  
aged between 45 and 74



## Why participate?

The Programme Mammographie must comply with national and European quality standards, to ensure quality of the results.

Two independent readings enable 25% more cancers to be detected: the mammogram result is seen by two radiologists independently (*in case of disagreement, a new examination of the file is made by the two radiologists together*).

Cancers detected as part of the Programme are usually found at an earlier stage: repeated screening means that cancer can be found earlier and therefore women have a better prognosis for recovery.

Mammography is 100% covered by the CNS.

In the case of an “abnormal” mammogram, the Programme Mammographie will continue to monitor your case.

## How do I get tested?

- I make an appointment for a mammogram at the radiology centre of my choice.
- I give the mammogram voucher to the ATM (it ensures the payment of the fees).
- If I have old images or CDs, I take them with me to entrust them to the ATM.

## And after the mammogram?

The result will be sent to my doctor and myself.

Additional examinations are sometimes necessary.

In 9 times out of 10, the mammogram results will show a benign abnormality and no cancer will be detected. It is always good to be on the safe side.

In spite of all the precautions taken, some cancers are not detected with screening and can manifest themselves after a normal mammogram result. It is therefore important that you pay attention to any clinical changes that occur in your breasts and consult your doctor if necessary.

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
